Today's Meditation....On our Hearts!



Our readings for this week should convince us to open our hearts

to the power of God's passionate love. Jeremiah foretold of a time in the future when God would do something new to help us understand and be a part of God's relationship with his people. Then Jesus brings this to pass with his life, sacrifice and resurrection. Now, we know God's way, love and forgiveness within our very being....on our hearts!

Jeremiah predicted a time when God would make a new covenant with Israel...one that would replace the "old" Mosaic code under which they lived. It was not to happen in their time...but in some future date. We have seen it happen! We are under that "New Covenant" instituted and formalised by the death of Jesus Christ, our blood sacrifice. For Jesus took upon himself both the blame and the punishment which belongs to each one of us because of our sin. He has turned death into life!
