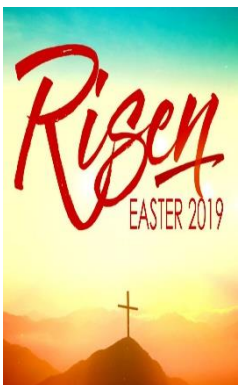

Reflections 21.3.2. Mark 11: 1 -11



“Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord!” As we

enter fully into Holy Week, like the crowds on that first Palm Sunday, we rejoice and cry out our joy and wonder. Our King comes, not in glorious splendour, but humbly, and riding on a donkey.

All the Gospels include this event, but for each writer, what happened is told from a particular point of view, and with emphasis and meaning all their own. Mark tells us that Jesus enters the city rather late in the afternoon; he and the disciples and crowds go forward to the Temple. But Jesus and the disciples leave the city and go back to Bethany.

His actions that day contradict what he has done till now. He has always commanded silence on many of the events that have occurred, but now he enters the public arena in a way that stirs up the movement against him. Jealousy, fear and rage fill the hearts of the religious leaders, and he knows what is coming!

This day, the crowds greet Jesus with great joy and praise. The irony is very clear in Mark just how quickly they turn. All too soon they demand the release of a common criminal, and the death of the One whom they had proclaimed “...comes in the name of the Lord!”

The Psalm proclaims this day, “The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone” (118: 22).
