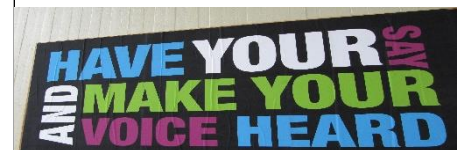

Reflection on Matthew 20:1-16 and Exodus 16:2-15...God's Amazing Grace!



Both readings underline how unstintingly God freely provides, even when we grumble. Even

though God proved his goodness and love to the Israelites, over and over again, liberating them from Egypt, providing water and leading them towards the Promised Land in a pillar of cloud, they fretted, worried, grumbled and complained. And, yet, in his love he gave them food, manna for the hungry!

Jesus tells the story about a landlord employing workers in his vineyard. Those who began work at the break of day, and those who worked only for the last hour, all received the same pay. Those who worked hard all day complained about this unfairness and the landlord explained he had every right to reward as he pleases. God's amazing grace!

At times, we're like the children of Israel on their way to the Promised Land and like the workers in the vineyard. We constantly compare what we have been given with what others have. We feel our long hard work should net us some brownie points over those who have come in at the last. We worry what the future will bring, and we forget that it is only the love and grace of God that has brought us salvation leading us on into the future.

This parable is about salvation! What God gives us comes from the goodness of his heart...his free gift to us! We do not earn it! To serve and love God from the beginning of the day is an enriching experience in itself. Grace, in this parable, is clearly in the call. It is seen in the owner's search and his need for workers, in his repeated invitation to each one of us. When we respond, he accepts us, as we are, whether it happens at the end of our earthly life or at its beginning. For that's God's amazing grace offered to us all!

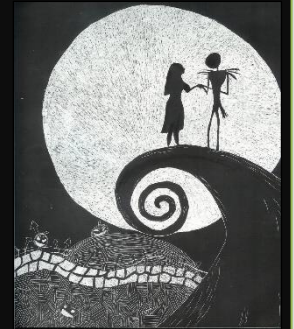
