A letter from Paul:

Reflections on Philippians 3: 4b-14...The Christian Journey



Once again in our reading from the Gospel of Matthew a Parable, and this one is about a wedding feast. Now, if I were to choose, would I prefer to preach on this

passage in Matthew relating of this parable or the one from Luke (14:15-24), I would choose Luke every time. It's much more straightforward and clearer, without the violence contained in Matthew.

The meal is a wedding feast, hosted by a king for his son. The meal is ready, and the servants are sent to bring in the guests. They are badly mistreated, and even killed, rather like the servants in the parable of the wicked tenants, (Matt 21: 35-36).

Understandably, the king reacts with rage, and the feast is delayed long enough for the king to marshal his troops and destroy these ungrateful guests, and even burn their city. (Remember, Matthew is written after Jerusalem has been sacked by the Romans about 70 AD.)

So, the story continues.... Another group of servants go out and bring in the uninvited guests from the streets and the wedding hall is filled. Once again, this points rather directly to the Jewish authorities who rejected Jesus.

When the king arrives, he sees a man without wedding garments. (I've always had sympathy for this man.) It seems a rather harsh punishment to be cast out to the 'outer darkness' where there is crying and gnashing of teeth! (v13).

This stops us being smug. The *issue* is that we should never judge. Matthew's community, just like ours, consists of both 'good and bad.' The allegory of the wedding garment could be any of these things, 'doing the will of my Father' or producing 'fruit of the kingdom'.

There needs to be consistency between speech and life. What matters to God is a life without pretence or guile, a life that takes seriously the grace of God.
