

Reflection around Mark 1:14-20...Follow Me!



Here is the first real view of Jesus at work. He has been baptised and been recognised by the Holy Spirit.

But Jesus now picks the right moment to act. While John was preaching about the one to come, Jesus bided his time. When John is arrested and put in prison, Jesus prayed and knew it was time to act. God does seem to speak through situations and events as well as through his still small voice in the centre of our hearts.

So, how to begin? First, he preaches! He wanders around Galilee and proclaims that the time promised by God has come at last. Then he walks along the shore of the Sea of Galilee and watches as Simon and Andrew and the sons of Zebedee,

James and John, were preparing to go fishing. This was their craft...this was the family business which would be handed down from father to son.

Jesus must have seen the potential for what they would learn and what would be their final destiny in the extension of the Kingdom of God on earth. He chose people just like you and me to use in his ministry and mission. He tells them to follow him, and he would train them to become fishers of men. Jesus called, and immediately they left behind all they ever knew to follow him into an unknown future. They never wavered, never downed tools and went home. They believed Jesus was their Master, guide and friend, the promised Messiah. Jean


