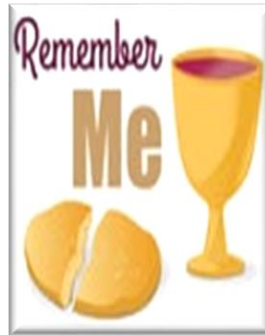

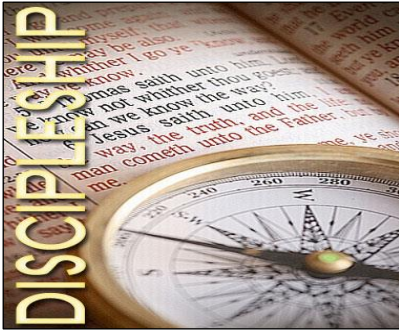

Reflection on Mark 8: 31-38 Lent 2



We have now entered this Lenten period, knowing that it is a time of challenge. Rev. Ansie put that

challenge before us last Sunday, as we were reminded not to procrastinate, but to do today those things that God calls us to do.

The passage from Mark this week presents us with a further step in our challenge along this Lenten journey. Jesus quite clearly predicts his suffering, death and resurrection. In the passage just previous, Peter has made that wondrous declaration that Jesus is the Messiah, the One all Israel has been longing for.

But it's Peter who takes Jesus aside to rebuke him for saying these things. Jesus turns the tables and rebukes Peter, "Get

behind me Satan!" Peter has shown that he has very little understanding of what it means to follow Jesus.

Jesus calls us to put aside our own life to follow. Our actions and our living must show that we value Christ, and his call above anything in this world that has a claim on us. Our lives, our worship, our witness and service should all point to Jesus and His call on our lives.

As we praise and worship him, as we witness to his love, mercy and grace, and as we serve that world for which Christ died, we are carrying our Cross. Not just in our personal lives, but in our life as a Church community, we need to demonstrate that the call of Christ is central to who we are, and to all we do. What a challenge we face, as individuals, and as a community of faith.
