Reflections around Mark 1:29-39...Prayer Time



I wonder if Jesus became bone tired after all the teaching and healing, he managed to

fit into a day. Today's reading outlines his very busy day in Capernaum after he had taught in the synagogue, healed the deranged man, the day just got busier. At Simon's house, he healed Simon's mother-in-law, and, maybe, he thought he was finished for the day. Not so! The town had heard of his miraculous and compassionate healings, and they were here with the sick and to witness these amazing healings. His fame was spreading like wildfire!

So, here's a very busy man with a never ending stream of people coming to him with problems to be solved and afflictions to be healed. Jesus has every reason to be exhausted and depleted. So, what does he do? After a short sleep, he slips out of the house early, probably before the others are even awake and heads out to a deserted place to be alone to pray.

Jesus renewed his energy, recharged his batteryand redefined his calling by getting in touch with God. Jesus found time alone to pray. In that brief time apart, Jesus finds new strength and the energy to continue his journey of love and service. In that time, he spurned the temptation to trade on his popularity and he was ready to move on into his God-given mission.

He had the people in the palm of his hand. But, when his disciples track him down to tell him that the people are hanging on his every word, what does he say and do? He says, let's go someplace else so that I can do what I came to do. That important prayer gave him the strength to stay focussed!

Finding time for prayer is not always easy... but prayer is the vital link between us and God. It was for Jesus and so it is for us!


