Easter Sunday

HE IS RISEN! He is risen indeed! This declaration of our faith is heard right around the world, in thousands of languages, and millions of congregations on this day. It's only a few short hours ago that we were taken to the tomb in the garden. The very life of our Lord has been given up. Where is hope?? Where is Life?? His body has been laid in a tomb, in a garden.

Early on this first Easter Day the women come to attend to his body. But the tomb is empty! In this place of devastation, the cemetery, there is also new life, growth, change, life! Mary had come to honour the sacredness of love, but the body is gone. He Is Risen!

It was hard to understand then, and in the most practical ways of our wisdom and looking at life, it's still hard to understand. Accepting is *faith*, one of God's precious gifts to us, and all who believe.

Our own lives include these two combinations, life and death. In the hardest of times, we know there is hope. We say, "after the storm, the sun comes out", and so it proves to be. When we trust in our Lord, we know that the most bitter of experiences have seeds of hope ready to spring up.

We may say that our lives are like that garden, death and life existing together. The Good News for all people in all times is that we have a Gardener, who calls us by name. He is always bringing new life from those places of desolation.

On this Easter Day, we can declare that hope is stronger than memory, that love overcomes death, and that with Jesus, we have an Eternal Saviour. HE IS RISEN! He is risen indeed!
