

Easter Sunday 31st March

Isaiah 50:4 – 9a Psalm 31:9 – 16 Philippians 2: 5 – 11 Mark14:1 – 15, 47 Mark 15: 1 - 39





Reflection....Mark 11:1-11....A Misunderstood Procession

This week we walk with Jesus and his disciples into Jerusalem with the cheering crowd throwing their garments in front of a borrowed donkey that Jesus is riding. They are waving branches and shouting, "Praise God! Blessings on the One who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessings on the coming Kingdom of our ancestor David....praise God in highest heaven! Hosanna....Save us now!"

We feel the excitement and the joy of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. Yet we are hesitant to celebrate because we know, just like He does, what lies aheada horrific sacrifice necessary to wipe out the consequences of our sin. But not even the disciples were aware of what lay ahead though they have been told and taught about the kind of Messiah he was and what awaited him in Jerusalem.

The people were finding things hard. Taxes were heavy and life under Roman rule wasn't easy. They longed for freedom and a kingdom like King David's of old. To them, it seemed like it was all about to happen with Jesus entering as a conquering hero. Amongst this, how did Jesus feel? As he headed into Jerusalem, we know his heart was heavy with the knowledge of what awaited him in Jerusalem and that sadness was magnified because the people and, even his disciples, misunderstood his mission.

This king came riding a donkey... not on horseback. He came in peace. He came in peace to bring peace. As the week unfolded, he didn't seem to be the one they expected, and those cheers turned from Hosanna to Crucify! The misconceptions of that crowd spells out a vital lesson for us. **We** don't set God's agenda.... **We** don't serve with our preconceived ideas about what Jesus can do for us. We wait on him and follow when he calls to guide us ever onwards! Jean
