Last weekend we were privileged to be part of the moving and challenging remembrance and celebrations of those momentous events of the first Easter. We once more acclaimed "Christ has risen – he has risen indeed".

But Easter is not just a weekend! The Easter season in our church calendar lasts for 49 days – 7 weeks – which culminate in Pentecost Sunday. So, during these seven weeks we gather together to hear stories of the risen Christ, and to remember the growth and struggles on the early Church. Today, John confronts us with the change that is available to us all in the aftermath of the resurrection.

The grieving, frightened men, locked together in a Jerusalem room were feeling lost and demoralised. They had witnessed so many amazing events, been trained and taught by the Master but for what now? There seems to be no future ahead!

Suddenly a voice says, "Peace be with you! "Who could it be? the door is locked! This is their life-changing moment; this made all the difference for their future and ours. Instead of pointing out their failures, Jesus offers them what they most needed. Peace and the power of the Holy Spirit. Peace be with you, he says, As the Father has sent me, so I send you. He breathes on them and says, Receive the Holy Spirit, with that breath of life. The Risen Christ gave power to the powerless sending them out beyond the locked door with hope in their hearts to form a church.

Absent Thomas needed proof! Just one week later, he also met this Saviour face to face and touched those nail holes. Falling to his knees, with awe and conviction, he proclaims Jesus as God. From silence to speech, from doubt to belief, they went on to courageously lead Christ's church with courage, joy and conviction.
