


The Uniting Church in Australia Warwick, Killarney & Freestone Uniting Parish



Surprised by Joy....John 15:9-17 - Easter 6

Last week, Jesus used the word picture of the vine, the branches and the resultant fruit. This week Jesus continues to give his farewell advice and commands. These instructions and his encouraging words of wisdom culminate in their being told they are not his workmen, but his friends. He tells them that they are loved and that they will be filled with joy, joy that will overflow.

Almost hidden, is the suggestion that being a disciple will fill us with overwhelming joy. It's not just the joy of realising what Jesus has done for us...I think it's the joy of being surprised by the unexpected...a joy that comes from giving...a joy that comes from believing that amazing story how God in Christ saved us from our sin and so gave us the promise of eternity.

Tragically Jesus dies...but then the resurrection turned everything upside down and we can share in the joy those disciples felt. But that joy is also ours when we realise those events were achieved for us all. Though facing persecution, those earliest Christians were people with love in their hearts and songs on their lips.

When hearts are changed by Christ, the world's standards of happiness and joy are reordered. So, when Jesus adds that we will have abundant joy amongst his commandments about loving, we can grasp and hold the promise that joy is a part of our faith. Joy surrounds us whether it be exuberant or a contented peace.

Love one another as I have loved you, says Jesus. Discipleship is not a solitary life. It's a community; so, it's not enough to just quietly go about our own commitment. If we all connected to each other using our own God-given gifts, then that's what enables the Spirit of God to speak to the world. How we act together is the greatest witness that we can show the world and the joy we exhibit speaks volumes
