## **Reflection on Mark 4:26-34 and 1 Samuel 15 and 16...God's Kingdom**

Our readings for today invite us to consider what it could mean to us to see as God sees....to trust him as he works outside of our human ways of doing things. The very young, unlikely candidate, David, emerges as God's chosen vessel and God's realm grows from mustard seed beginnings. Through these stories, how might we hear and see ourselves chosen by God.....And for what?

Jesus uses two parables to illustrate the growth of The Kingdom of God, using what the people knew about...planting and growth. The seed is planted and the miracle of growth takes place without the farmer's knowledge of just how it works. Then the smallest of seeds can produce an amazing big and useful tree. He is describing how the tremendous growth of the Kingdom of God can really happen.

He is also pointing out that the most successful lives in God's eyes may arise out of the smallest and the least significant of people. For deep within each of us lies the treasure that God sees.... Deeply embedded in the heart lies the mustard seed that can grow into that sheltering and protective fruitful tree. God sees the potential in little ordinary you and me whom he calls and chooses to do some of the work of the Kingdom.

This is the clear message from both of our readings this morning. Deep within each of us lies the treasure that God sees. Deeply God saw that potential in the young, insignificant David. God can see the same potential in little ordinary you and me whom he calls and chooses to do some of the work of the Kingdom motivated by the love and care that flows through us from God himself. We are only the field he uses, and we are just a member of his team!.....
