Reflection on Ephesians 1:3-14....Paul's Vision for the Church

It is thought that Paul wrote this letter from his prison cell in Rome. In the opening verses of his words to the church at Ephesus, he is so excited that there is no stopping his outpouring of words. They become one mighty, poetic hymn of wonder and joy. At the heart of his excitement is the conviction that, in Jesus, the secret of the universe has been revealed... the very meaning of human history.

God's purpose is *to bring together all things in Christ...things in heaven and things on earth....*all things brought into harmony. Just imagine what that would be like! One family of God...one loving body of people....one church of Christ! Paul asserts that this is what Christ has begun and nothing will ever stop its ultimate implementation. The presence of Christ moves us away from disunity and fragmentation and gathers us into one with him, God being the parent of us all. This is Paul's message and his life's example!

He declares that God really loves his creation...that heaven touches earth...that God the Father loves all his children. This passage was music written from the heart of an old man out of years of experience in the faith...a hymn about a world without barriers or divisions....a song that touched the hearts of his fellow worshippers, and still touches us today.

What, then does this mean for us? Does our worship, both private and corporate, celebrate the living, dying and rising of Christ, our Redeemer's ultimate victory over sin and death? Do we embrace all as citizens of God's church? In our worship, may we always respond in passionate and heartfelt songs of praise, letting God break in to touch our lives... to transform and renew us. May Paul's vision of the meaning of God's cosmic plan become ours! ...Jean
