



Reflection on John 6:56-69...Hard Teaching. Pentecost 14.

Here was Jesus, the hero of Galilee, the miracle worker, the wise one who could look into your heart and bring new hope...the one who is so close to God that he could feed the multitude on five loaves and two fish. But now he has gone beyond the limits of the understanding of those following him. He tells them that the loaves and the fish only satisfy them for a day, but that eating his flesh and drinking his blood would satisfy them forever for he is the bread of heaven which God has prepared for them. Well, that's when they leave him!

Are Christ's teachings so difficult that we also give up, ignore them and so reject him? Or do we have the courage to stand and act on God's truth? God has given us the gift of choice and so, whether we follow or turn away, it's up to us. We come to that turning point and make the decision: Commit our lives to Godor go our own way.

God made us in his image and gave us the freedom to love and to live as we will. What does he expect in return? All he hopes is that we come to love him with all our heart, soul, and mind. God in Jesus is asking us to accept him as we accept a meal, trusting in its value and its wholesomeness. He is the heavenly food that nourishes forever!

This is the teaching Jesus was revealing. It marked a turning point in the responses of those following enthusiastically up till then. Many now abandon him! Jesus turns to the twelve and asks if they also would leave, but Peter replies, "Lord, to whom would we go? You have the words that give eternal life...We believe and know you are the Holy One of God." Do we echo those words of Peter?......Shalom, Jean
