

Reflection on Hebrews 1:1-4, 2:5-12 and Mark 10:13-16

In so much that is happening around our world, many wonder *Where is God?* And *what does he believe about the worth of people like us?* Both these readings leave us in no doubt that God cares deeply about each one of us and he went to extraordinary lengths to make it possible for us to know him personally and to have a relationship with him.

Where is God? Right here; It is here in his love that we reflect to each other, and to the hurting and vulnerable around us. This reading from Hebrews opens with a contrast between the shadowy partial revelation of God in the past, and the fullness of that revelation of God in Christ. God bridged that gap between himself and humanity by becoming a human being, revealing himself by speaking through his Son, Jesus Christ.

When we know Jesus, we have all we need to be saved from the consequences of our sin and to have a perfect relationship with our God. The writer of Hebrews reminds us that, not only is Christ the exact representation of God, he is God himself, eternal, loving, gracious the complete expression of God in human form. Hebrews continues to stress what Jesus did for us, and what he still does through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Mark shows us this Jesus who welcomed little children into his arms, welcoming the great and the small of us, no matter who we are! We can reach out to grasp the Jesus who is right here with us, in our hearts, calling us to follow him. That's how much God believes in us! How much he loves us! The story of the children being welcomed by Jesus after being dismissed by the disciples is very comforting. Jesus' arms enfold all of us, all his adopted children.

He is here...and we do matter! Shalom, Jean






Care Corner
