Readiness:- Grace x (Serve + Love) = Life Abundant

Reflection - Luke 19:28-40



Palm Sunday is a time for celebration as the Scriptures remind us of that triumphant ride into Jerusalem. Jesus and his disciples come towards Jerusalem, and Jesus is riding on a borrowed donkey. The crowd, encouraged by the disciples, begins to cheer, "God bless the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory to God!" What a sight it must have been! Jesus at last being recognized as a king!

The Pharisees are not amused. For all sorts of reasons, they want this parade to finish. Fear of Roman reprisals, jealousy, rage at this impudent Rabbi... whatever was going on for them, they say to Jesus, "Teacher, command your disciples to be quiet!" No mistaking what they were demanding.

Jesus answers, "I tell you that if they keep quiet, the stones themselves would start shouting." (v.40 Good News Bible). It's rather a curious thing that in the Scriptures all of Creation is included in celebration, renewal, devastation and loss. We humans see stones as building materials, or hiding minerals, or sometimes a nuisance, but Jesus describes Creation as celebrating this day, as he rides into the Holy City.

God's redemption, won through the death and resurrection of Jesus, is for all Creation. Palm Sunday, as we read again this passage from Luke, reminds us that God's plan is for his Love to hold all Creation, and all Creatures in a peace that passes all understanding. Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the Name of the Lord!! Rev May
