


The Uniting Church in Australia Warwick, Killarney & Freestone Uniting Parish

Reflection on John 17:20-26... Christ Seen in You and in Me

Today, we listen to the end of Jesus' prayer for his disciples, just before he goes to the garden for his private prayer with his Father before his arrest. He prays for all of us disciples that we will be united...one in God, in Christ and in the Holy Spirit...for this is how the whole world will know him in unity and in glory.

That they may be one, as we are one, I am living in them, you are living in me...that their unity may be complete. So shall the world know that you sent me and that you loved them as you loved me. Note that little word "so." It highlights how the world knows that God is present, that his love is seen where people touch each other's lives ...spending quality time together, listening with Christ's grace, being "one" united in his Kingdom. In other words, the revelation of God's love is found in our relationships both with God and with each other.

Do we really stop to see Christ in each other? We are all different in our needs and abilities, in our hopes and desires, in the depth of our faith and in what we can offer Christ. But it all works when we come right back to relationships...to the love of Christ within us, and then to recognising the love of God in others. Our differences don't matter if we have a unity of purpose, that mission to spread God's hope and love to all we meet. That is what makes us one!

So, unity does not mean sameness; we complement each other in our reaching out into the world with our message of the Kingdom, displaying the love of Christ within each of us disciples. That's what Jesus is praying for us...to recognise Christ's love mirrored within each of us....


