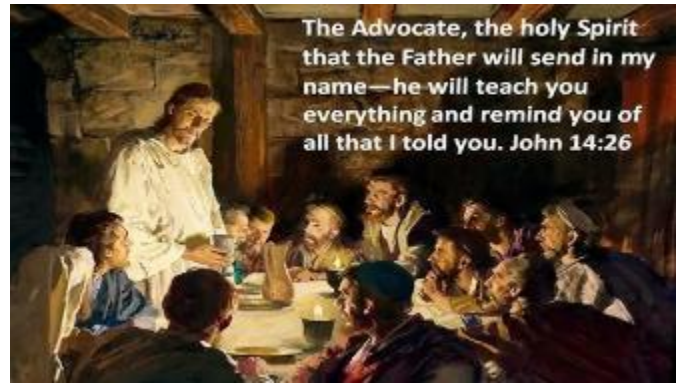

Reflection... John 14: 23 -29

This passage from John is in the time prior to Easter, prior to his death and resurrection, where Jesus is teaching his disciples that he won't always be with them.

He speaks of their obedience, because he is teaching them of all they need to know to follow Him and know God.



“Whoever loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and I and my Father will come and live with him. Whoever does not love me does not obey my teaching. And the teaching you heard is not mine but comes from the Father who sent me.” Jesus goes on to tell them about the Holy Spirit, the Helper, the Advocate, who will help these disciples to remember all the teaching.

Jesus then goes on with a blessing, “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.” Jesus gives his peace in a way that the world never gives. It is free, it is abundant, and it is given without strings attached. The love that comes with this peace flows through all our lives and breaks down all the barriers that the world put in place, prejudice, injustice, societies rules and worldly power.

I pray this peace will fill your life today and always Amen
