Reflection :- Luke 10: 25 -37 Who is my neighbour?

This is a question that has been pondered for centuries. The original asker was trying to trick Jesus into revealing where he stood in the eyes of the religious law at that time. This lawyer also wanted to justify why he felt that Jesus was a fraud and needed to be taken down a peg or two. What he received from Jesus was a lesson in the love, mercy and grace of God, shown in a parable!

The parable Jesus told about the poor man who was attacked on the road to Jericho has become part of our social understanding. When unexpected people come forward to help, we say, "They are a Good Samaritan". The Good Samaritan has become a secular saint, with helping groups, civic awards and even hospitals named after him.

The parable about the good religious men passing by on the other side of the road would not have come as a surprise to the original hearers. Where they would have been confronted was when a scorned Samaritan stopped and offered all that was needed. Jesus then asks the lawyer the question, "Which person was the neighbour to the poor man in the ditch?" and the lawyer has to admit that it was the hated Samaritan.

Just so does Christ himself help those in society who are neglected, ignored or despised by all. The Samaritan symbolizes our Divine Prophet.
