Reflection: Luke 14; 7-14...Important Lessons for Us

Jesus was invited to an important, religious man's house for dinner. In that time, dinners were not simply meals....they were social events which bonded people of similar status together. The seating arrangements were crucial because people expected to eat with their social equals. The closer the guests were seated to the host, the greater the honour he bestowed on them.

So, here is Jesus carefully watching the behaviour of the guests....all important people with a social standing to maintain. Each is seeking out one of the best places at the table, the places of honour where they will be noticed by the other guests, where, by being close to the host, they will be served first and receive the best of the food and drink.

Then Jesus launches into some advice for them... and for us. He is using the occasion to describe the Kingdom of God. For God's reign is not about measuring up, but simply about being invited by God; a warning not to think too highly of ourselves. Humility would seem to be the touchstone of this advice...the humility to recognise that it is up to our host...up to God to seat us and grant us honour as he chooses. In fact, God promises that every seat is a good one when we respond to his invitation to come to him. But humility is not thinking less of ourselves...it is all about thinking of ourselves less! There's the first lesson!

In our gospel reading for today, Jesus teaches us two lessons: He tells us that a life of service is more important in God's kingdom than status... and then he challenges us not to be exclusive because God opens his Kingdom to all. The church should be a place where all are welcome! The empty places around us need to be filled by us as we help God bringing others into his Kingdom. Shalom, Jean
