Reflection Luke 16: 1 -13

This passage about the unjust steward is very puzzling. If he has squandered his master's estate, then he's a criminal, but if he has been careless, he's just very inept, a poor manager. In either case, neither of these scenarios is critical for the understanding of this complicated parable.

The fact we come to, is that he is dismissed by the master, and is asked, as his final duty, to provide an audit of his work in settling the debts of his master. Now, we see the manager's actions with this task as certainly self-preservation. He put the debtors in his debt by lowering their loans. In this way he creates network of clients who owe him favours. He certainly doesn't want to become a beggar or even a ditch-digger. For his shrewdness he is commended.

But where is the Christian teaching in this parable? We find more enlightenment in the last few verses of the passage. "If you can't be responsible and reliable with your money, how can you expect to be a steward of things that really matter?" (paraphrased v.11)

This passage, taken in context with several previous chapters raises serious questions about our attitudes towards money and possessions, and all things we can become attached to. It also addresses how we help the poor. Do we put others in our debt? or do we help people to feel equal, and become friends?

To build God's kingdom, we need to be constantly giving people a 'hand up,' rather than a 'hand out.' We restore their self-worth, so they too can praise God. Rev May
