



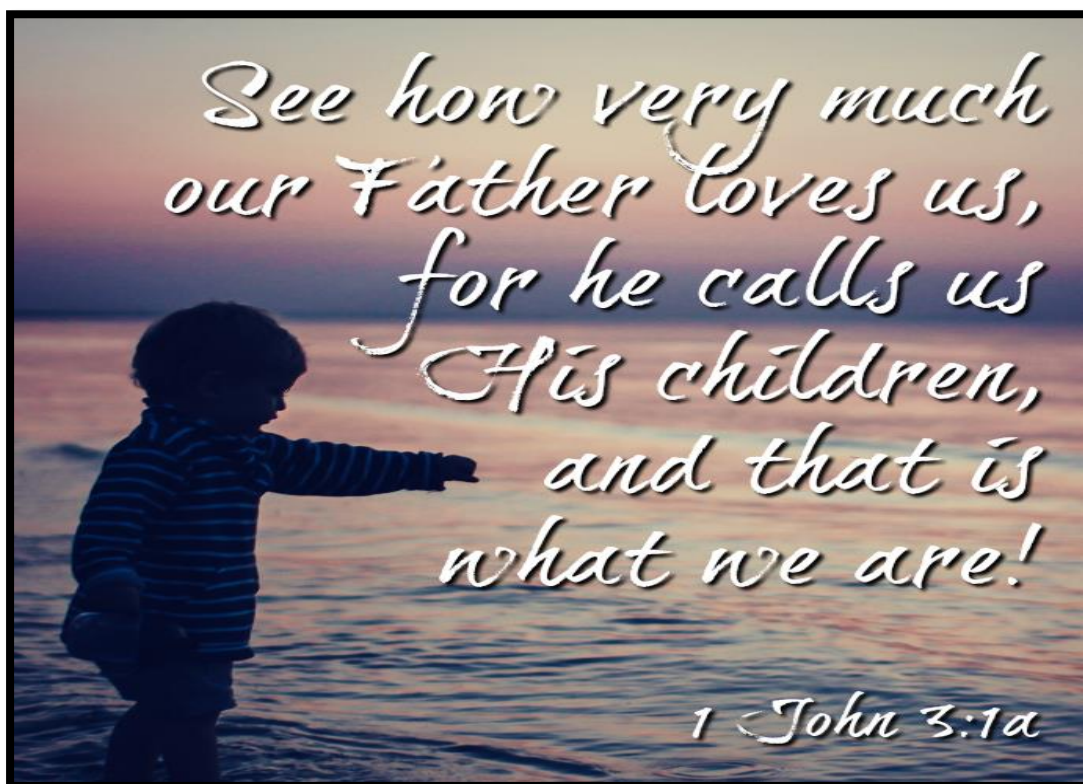

Reflections Luke 14: 25 -33

The passage we engage with this week is one we rather skip over. Jesus is travelling towards Jerusalem, and large crowds begin to follow him. Jesus is concerned and challenges them with the cost of discipleship.

Leave your families, let go of the life you want to lead, give your money away, carry your cross and follow me! All these statements jar. They confront us with very hard choices and remind us that being a Christian is never easy. We can put aside any ideas of social enhancement or riches.

The location of this passage is quite critical. Jesus has just told the parable of the great banquet. The invited guests give all sorts of excuses when told that the feast is ready. So, the Master sends out his servants to invite in the poor, the crippled, the blind and lame, and those who live in the countryside so his banquet will be eaten. This is a remarkable story of Divine grace.

It is easy to make presumptions about grace, and Jesus wants to be sure that the large crowds following him are genuine, and not just ready for an easy ride. He offers two illustrations about being prepared for the future, the building of a tower, and the king who plans to go into battle. God has plans for the future, and he calls us to join Him in the building, and in the battles. God means to win. He knows the costly nature of winning the victory; he gave his only Son to ensure the overthrow of sin. He calls us to be just as committed, and as Psalm 139 reminds us, he knows us, and we belong to Him. What a mighty God we serve! Rev May
