Reflections: Luke 17: 5 -10

In our passage again this Sunday, we are faced with a difficult parable. Parables like this one have been known to scare off preachers, to look for some passage that is easier. But let's look to find some truth for ourselves.

The apostles have been put to the test in the verses just prior, so they ask Jesus to increase their faith. He reassures them by saying "If you had faith the size of a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." Jesus doled out, not to be measured by 'more,' or 'less.' The image of the dutiful servant may not seem very positive, but Jesus himself gave us the example of the dutiful servant, the One who washes feet, forgives sin, hears prayers, supplies needs 'I have come among you to serve,' (22:27).

This parable reminds us that God is God, and we are God's creatures, no more and no less than that. If we imagine God owing us a debt for all we do, we skew the truth. When we completed all we are called to do, quietly and faithfully, we point the way for others to see the amazing grace of God, working in and through us! Our faith means that we are open to God's power, and He can do wonderful things in and through us.
