

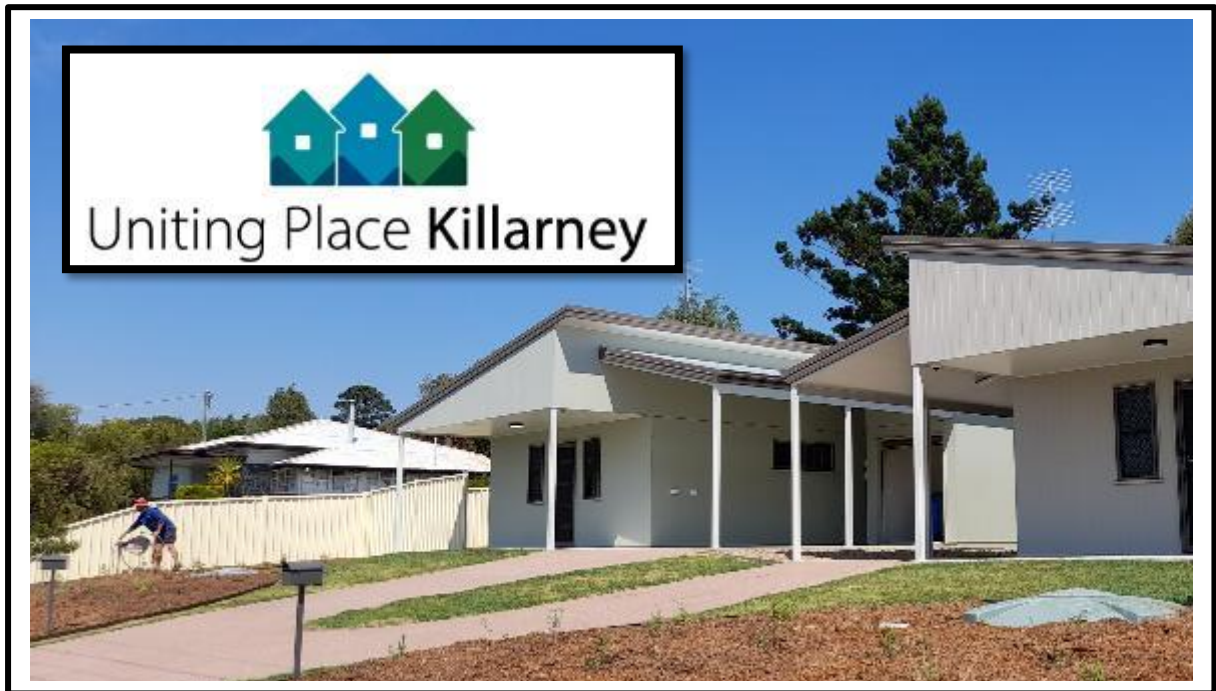

Reflection: Luke 17:11-19....A Surprising Example of Faith and Thanks

Our readings for today proclaim God as the source of life and wholeness....the one who cares about all people, even those upon whom the world has turned its back. On his way through Samaria to Jerusalem to face the agony of the cross, Jesus encounters 10 lepers, untouchable outcasts cut off from home and family and all that makes life worthwhile. Mindful of the rules of their society, they call out from a distance, "Jesus, Master have mercy on us!" What desperate hope lies in that plaintive cry!

But, miracle of miracles, Jesus does respond even to them. He responds by telling them to go and show themselves to the priests as healed people to be given permission to return to normal society! As they walk forward to do this, they miraculously find themselves healed. As the ten gleefully race off, one turns back, falls on his knees before Jesus and gives him heartfelt thanks and praise. And Jesus looks into him and says something strange and yet so important. He says, "Get up and go on your way....your faith has made you well." He was a hated Samaritan neighbour! and realises that his healing came from God through Jesus and now he has a relationship with God, a relationship that makes him whole and alive.

This story shows, faith is nothing more difficult or profound than remembering what God has done for us and giving him our thanks and praise. Grateful Christians grow in their understanding of God's grace. As we look around us, in so many ways we are overtaken with deep gratitude. Our faith then is about how God touches us and Christ embraces us; it is about how he transforms the ordinary into the joy of knowing that God's hand and God's heart lies in each and every moment of our days.
