

Affordable Homes – Uniting Place – Warwick and Killarney

Three years in the dreaming and now they are ready to be homes for singles and families – Uniting Place – Warwick and Killarney - 14 affordable homes in Warwick and Killarney, designed and built to a high standard of features.

These homes - 10 in Warwick and 4 in Killarney - are all equipped with ceiling fans and air-conditioning, solar panels and battery storage, carport, plenty of storage and well laid-out interior and are part of the Uniting Church's work to enrich the local community and to relieve the stress of rental accommodation. Both sites have a well-equipped community area and have landscaping to enhance the area. They are individually metered for water and power.

There is a mix of single and double bedrooms and some with disability access. To qualify for this affordable housing the applicant needs to match certain criteria: income ceiling dependant on family size, asset tests and other factors. Most of them have occupants ready to move in but there are a few in both Warwick and Killarney that at this stage have not been allocated.

As Affordable Housing, rental is set at 75% of the market value and is managed by a not-for-profit Queensland company, but expressions of interest can be collected from the Warwick Uniting Church office 37 – 39a Guy St – Tuesday – Friday, 9am – 12pm, and Regional Housing Limited 1300 642 123.
