Reflections - Matthew 24: 36-44

We are entering our time of Advent, a time when we begin to be swept up in the busyness and hurry of Christmas. This is a time when we put on ourselves a lot of stress to complete our shopping, cleaning, cooking, invitations, and so on.

BUT it is also a time when we are invited by our Scripture reading to look forward to the celebration of the greatest gift that has ever been given to the World, the gift of Jesus our Saviour!!

The passage from Matthew this week is a reminder that we don't know the day nor the hour when our lives will be completely changed. Not even the Son of Man knows when He will return. I believe it's easier to celebrate the gift of Jesus the Christ Child, rather than confront the knowledge that this world will be judged, and the plans of God will be consummated.

So, we look for the hope that comes with Advent. The gift of Jesus is the greatest gift of all, and the knowledge that God is in control, in spite of all the signs contrary to this.
