## **Reflection on**

Reflections Luke 19:1-10 Luke's Gospel is the only Gospel giving us the story of Zacchaeus, which is rather remarkable, because most commentators label it a masterpiece. Zacchaeus is a tax collector, someone who is thoroughly despised by the rest of society. Why did he want to see Jesus? How did Jesus know his name? These questions are not answered in this passage.

But look what happens! Zacchaeus is short, so he climbs a tree to get a glimpse of Jesus. The crowds, probably, would have never let him in to the edge of the road. Jesus looks up and addresses this tax collector, perched in the tree. Further, Jesus invites himself to the home of Zacchaeus for a meal. Society labelled Zacchaeus as a sinner, a person who is excluded from the community, and is to be avoided at all costs.

What happens next is a miracle! Zacchaeus welcomes Jesus, implying hospitality and friendship, and Jesus pronounces salvation 'today', not some hope for the man in the future. The encounter is filled with joy, and Zacchaeus makes more than adequate restitution. He is very generous with his riches. Zacchaeus is declared a 'Son of Abraham', making him part of the community, and heir to all the promises given by God.

In spite of being a rather comic figure sitting up in the tree, Zacchaeus is a 'seeker', and Jesus meets him more than half-way. His persistence is rewarded, rather like the widow we met a couple of weeks ago who pestered the judge. How amazing for us, as we read this story, that we meet the Son of Man, who seeks and saves those who are lost. What a mighty God we serve. Blessings, May
