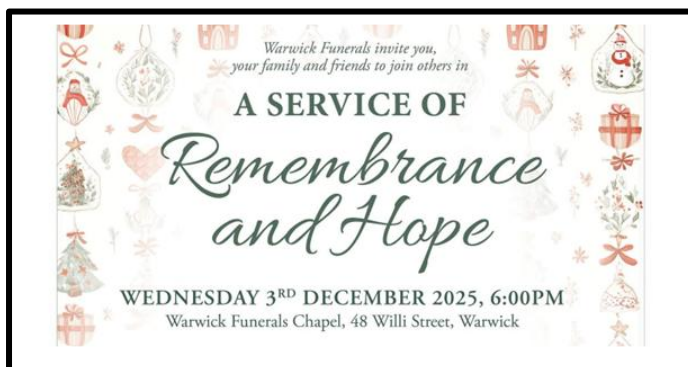

Reflection...Christ as King....Luke 23:33-43

Today marks the end of the church year for 2025 and hence the last of our readings from the Gospel of Luke, concluding all that it has revealed to us since the beginning of Advent and the appearance of Emmanuel, God with us as a tiny babe. We've celebrated and learnt all about God's plan for our Salvation and how bitterly it was bought for us. Our reading for today vividly brings us to that windswept hill with those three crosses, three men about to die, the middle one bearing the sign, "This is the King of the Jews." Here is the one who, in the midst of agony, prays, "Father, forgive them for they don't know what they are doing!"

One of the two criminals hears the insults from the crowd, joins in, and pleads for Jesus to save them if he is indeed the King of the Jews as he says. The other is silent as he turns his face to Jesus. He recognises who this man really is, confesses his sin to the sinless one, and speaks those words that we echo, "Remember me when you come into your Kingdom." And Jesus looks into his eyes and replies, "Today you will be with me in Paradise!" Here is Truth! Here is Christ the King completing what he came to do as he takes our sin and clinches our forgiveness.

Today then it must all come together into one concluding, exalting proclamation about Jesus Christ the "King of kings and Lord of lords." And today we must address that ultimate question about Christ's lordship in our own lives and in our world. The main job of the church is to keep on telling the news that Jesus Christ is King of Kings and Lord of Lords. For the battle has been won and victory is assured!Shalom, Jean
