Reflections.... Matthew 5: 1-12

Jesus begins his ministry of teaching, following his temptations in the wilderness. He begins in Galilee with the passage today, that we call the beatitudes. Matthew tells us that this happened in a mountainous region, but Mark records some of this teaching by the Sea of Galilee. As we read and ponder on the Beatitudes, we know that Jesus is offering all people a new way to live.

This teaching is about the way of being gentle, forgiving, loving and caring, and it goes against all of the teaching of the world - 'Look after No 1' and 'God helps those who help themselves', and 'You are the most important person in your life'. We can all be influenced by this way of seeing life without even realizing it.

One of the modern day Saints who understood this way of life was Mother Teresa who worked among the poor and destitute of India. As she served the dying and fed the starving, she saw the face of Jesus in each one. When people grasp this teaching to overcome division and difference, suffering and oppression, God's justice and mercy spring up, just like shoots from a burnt gum tree. Others often see it as foolishness, but this living gives hope into the world. Blessings, May.
