Reflection on Matthew 5: 13-20...A Little Makes a Big Difference!

The Sermon on the Mount continues! Talking to this motley group of ordinary followers, Jesus tells them that they are the salt of the earth and the light of the world. He doesn't say that they **will be**...he says that they **are**, and that through them, God would change the world for ever. As his disciples in the world of today, Jesus tells us the same, challenging us to make the enormous difference by shining his light into the darkness and adding that little seasoning that makes a huge difference to life.

You are the light of the world! Not a physical light, just a real and personal way of living with faith, hope and love. You bring the light of truth and justice, mercy and forgiveness. That's the light of God lying within us which then radiates from us. You are the light of the world, says Jesus....not you will be...but you are! So, as followers of Christ, we have been called and commissioned! We are to do the same work in the world as he does...to be bearers of light into the broken, battered world around us. We are the salt that adds flavour to a lost people

To be a secret Christian is not an option. To do this, says Jesus, is like putting a bucket over a candle....the starved light will decline to a flicker and eventually grow cold and die out. The choice is ours! We must be true to what we believe! So, here is our own personal challenge: where has Jesus, the light of the Word, called us to be light in our corner of his world? What is our task for 2026? The darkened world needs our witness, our words and our deeds ...so, go and let your light shine brightly as you obey his call!
