Give us grace to love one another, to following in the way of his commandments and to share his risen life with all the world, for he lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

Reflection on John 14:15-21...Love and Obedience

Jesus is still with his disciples at The Last Supper where he is preparing his disciples for what lies ahead for them, preparing to leave them as he obediently moves towards the cross in love for them and for us. Jesus tells them, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." Jesus links together love with obedience! He commands us to love; but he doesn't make God's love for us conditional upon our obedience. It is more like that because you love me, you will keep my commandments.

Remember also that his commandments were to love God and to love others! So, there is the link and it is really a cycle; love stimulates obedience and that obedience deepens our love which brings us ever closer to him which produces even more faithful and fruitful obedience. Conversely, a lack of love leads to disobedience making our faith seem unreal!

But Jesus didn't leave it there, he promises his disciples and us that we would have an Advocate who would never leave us, who would lead us into all truth...the Spirit of Christ within us. This Counsellor, the very Spirit of God himself, would come after Jesus left to care and guide all disciples. This Spirit is then the very essence of God within us helping us to love and obey, to live as God wants, building Christ's church here on earth.

On the night of his betrayal Jesus assures his disciples that they will see him again, that because he lives and continues to live, so will they. They will know that he is in the Father...that they are in him...and he is in them. So here we have the Trinity: God the Father, Jesus the Son and the Holy Spirit all revealed to us! God is with us; Christ is in us...and the Spirit is in and all around us. Look and see-love and obey! Jean
