**Reflection...** Trinity Sunday

Last week we celebrated the coming of the Holy Spirit. Like Christmas and Easter, Pentecost is not just about a single Sunday. We enter into the Season of Pentecost, which covers most of the Church calendar till Christ the King Sunday in November.

After the joy of Pentecost, today we are reminded of our Triune God of grace, The Father, The Son and the Holy Spirit. I guess this is a reminder that our faith needs to be nourished with the fullness of God. We are all familiar with denominations that put their emphasis on one aspect of the Trinity, but this Sunday reminds us all to embrace the wonder of a God whose very character is really beyond our knowing.

We shouldn't be discouraged in our pursuit of knowing God, as though God has not revealed much of Godself to us; and we should also be warned against believing that the inscrutable character of God is fully captured by our Creeds and formulations.

The character of God is endlessly urgent to the Church, and to God's people. We are called to reflect on this wonderful God, and to articulate our experience and love for God alone. The texts for today's readings tell us several things, God is the Great Creator, (Genesis 1), the God of grace is to be followed, (II Corinthians 13 and Matt 28), and of course, the majesty of this Gracious God is to be embraced as the cornerstone of our life. "Oh Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth". Psalm 8:1.
