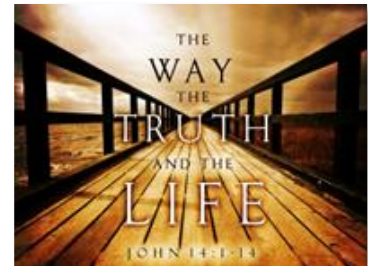

Prayer for today. All mighty and ever-living God, you hold together all things in heaven and on earth. In your great mercy, receive the prayers of your children, and give the spirit of your peace and truth, through Jesus Christ – our Saviour and Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

Reflection: John 14: 1-14

This passage from John's Gospel is very familiar. It forms part of the farewell speech by Jesus to his disciples as he faces the Cross. Firstly, Jesus promises the disciples a permanent existence with him, in life and beyond. He is acutely aware that their relationship will change with his death and resurrection, and he's offering assurance before the event.

This passage is often read at funerals for this very reason. "Whatever happens", is the promise, "I have already prepared a place for you." Jesus couldn't be clearer. There is a place, 'In my Father's house'. Wow!! What a promise.

"Where I am, you shall be there also" (v 4), this is truly a promise of relationship with Jesus beyond death. When Phillip asks to see the Father, Jesus again makes the declaration that He and the Father are one. This revelation is very clear in the Gospel of St. John. Perhaps it doesn't need to be said, but these promises of Jesus are made to comfort troubled hearts.

At that first Easter, the disciples are just devastated. We can go through similar heartache, when we lose a loved one, or when we face a devastating diagnosis. In times like these, we find our comfort, our strength, and our hope for the future, a future with Jesus our Lord and Saviour. God is our Rock and our Refuge forever.
