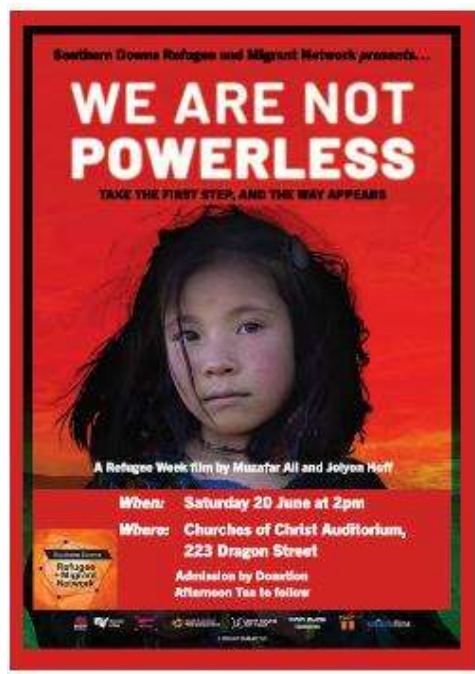

# TWEATT TODAY

## Prayer for today.

O God, you are the source of life and the ground of our being. By the power of your Spirit bring healing to this wounded world and raise us to the new life of your Son, Jesus Christ, Saviour and Lord.

## **Reflection: Matthew: 9:9-13, 18-26...Faith and Breaking down Walls**

Our Gospel reading for today gives us a glimpse of the way Jesus works in three episodes, each one calling on him in faith, and each one coming from different backgrounds. Here we see Jesus stepping beyond human walls to bring healing, love and an end to division as he responds to their faith in him.

Matthew was a tax collector, an outcast of the pious society, often little less than honest and God fearing. He was sitting at his tax collector's booth as Jesus walked by, looked him in the eye and said, "Follow me and be my disciple!" Matthew, the hated tax collector, heard the voice and immediately let go of all he knew and followed the one who called. He had a clear idea of what this would cost him and yet he never hesitated. He knew there would be no turning back, that he would have to change. He trusted Jesus, followed in faith, and became one of the 12, even though the Jewish leaders frowned in disapproval at Jesus' choice. Jesus saw beyond the outcast to his need, his faith and his potential within.

Next, we see the woman, another outcast because of her status and her affliction. She thought that she would be healed if she could just touch his clothes. She did; he knew; he healed her and commended her on her faith. In the same way a child was brought back to life through the faith of her father. Three people in different places with different needs, healed by the one who saw no walls!

Jesus said to Matthew *follow me!* And he does!

Jesus healed a woman, and said, *Go! Your faith has made you well.*

Jesus offers us healing and wholeness and then sends us out also.

What is our response? All we need is faith and tumbling walls!
