## **Reflection on Matthew 11:25-30...Come to Me, Take my Yoke upon You**

Here, we hear Jesus inviting us into a place of rest and peace by taking his yoke upon our shoulders and, thereby, living abundantly together as his team. He invites us into that special relationship that exists between himself and his Father finding the peace, the rest, and the comfort that comes from the Father, through the Son, to us. This rest enables us to renew our enthusiasm and lift our spirits.

Jesus invites us into that rest. We must be willing, not only to come, but also to let him help us with our burden. For he then says, *Come to me; take my yoke upon you and learn from me; and you will find rest for your souls.* A yoke joins two oxen together to work as a team. So, he is inviting us to join him in harness...to allow him to take the lead, and to let him help us through the difficult patches showing us how it's done.

In Jesus' day, yokes were made of wood. The ox was brought into the carpenter's shop, carefully measured, and then the yoke was roughed out. The ox was brought back, and the yoke carefully adjusted until it fitted exactly. Each yoke was tailor made to fit each ox. The word easy then means well fitting. The yoke we are invited to wear is the correct fit for us and for what we are called to do.

So, there it is... the call to come to Jesus and enter into a relationship with him. Jesus invites us into harness with him so that he might share our lives, give us rest and bring us peace – whatever lies before us. For the life to which Jesus invites us is at once restful, purposeful and useful; life that counts, calling us into serving each other. Shalom, Jean
