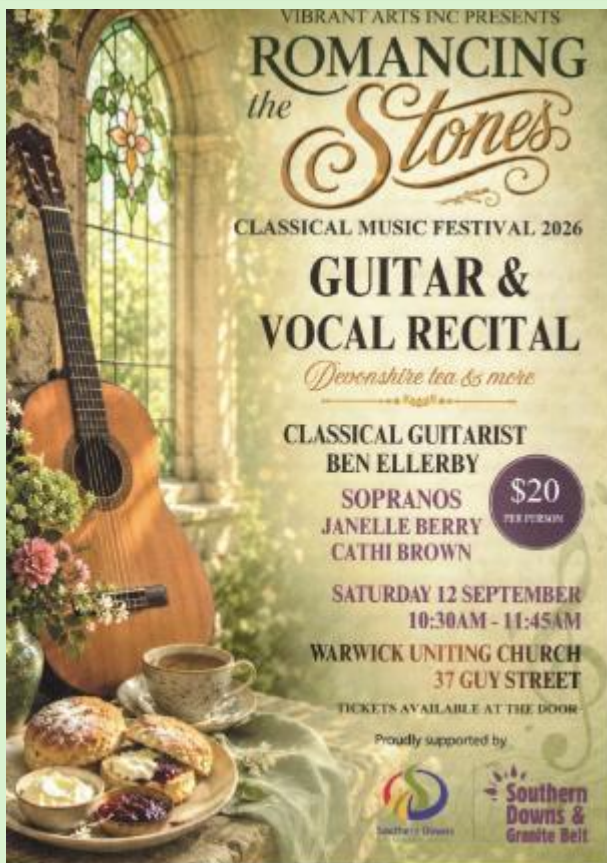

O Lord God, enliven and preserve your church with your perpetual mercy. Without your help, we mortals with fail. Remove far from us everything that is harmful and lead us towards all that gives life and salvation, through Jesus Christ, our Saviour and Lord.

Reflection on Matthew 18:15-20..... Restored and Forgiven

As his disciples, Jesus calls us to love and care for one another. But he asks even more! Because unity in the body of Christ is so important, Jesus calls us to risk. To call one another to account, and to offer and seek forgiveness. At the heart of the Christian gospel is the call to be related to one another, to search for and discover that sense of belonging. Discipleship life is not just an individual relation with Christ – it is life together.

Jesus call us to value relationships with our Christian brothers and sisters as highly as we value our own family, even if they are guilty of an offence. When a relationship is broken it is worth working towards reconciliation. So, Jesus gives us a set of guidelines to help us find a way through to that final reconciliation.

Firstly, the one who's offended against takes the initiative and goes to the other to speak the truth in love in order to try to resolve the issue. This is done in private, just between the two concerned. We are distinctly uncomfortable with conflict and direct confrontation But then Jesus says, "Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I with them." So, when we go to seek reconciliation with another to bring Christ's peace into the church community, then Christ is there with the two of us... $1+1 = 3$

We owe one another the kind of love God has shown us and we are called by Christ to be the first to reach out to our fellow Christian after a quarrel. the first to try to work things out after we have been sinned against... the first to seek reconciliation. the first to refuse to fret, or to be anxious, or to harbour a grudge because of what another has done to us. In this small way we mirror what God in his love has done for us. Shalom Jean.
